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CAMP DETAILS & INFORMATION

We will be traveling to Castaway Club – A Young Life Camp (51709 Co Hwy 31, Detroit Lakes, MN 56501) in an Arrow Stage Lines Charter Bus with professional driver and one, 12-passenger van with insured Campus Life staff drivers.

We will be staying on the campgrounds in separate boy and girl cabins, sleeping in Dorm Style rooms with multiple sets of beds (*bedding is provided*).

Each room is equipped with a private, full bathroom with multiple sinks and shower stalls (*1 towel is provided*).

After online registration, your child's online Health, Consent & Release form via CampDoc.com must be completed by May 24 (*or their spot may be forfeited*). Their camp balance must be paid in full by June 30 (they can work fundraisers after camp).

Students may bring and use electronics during travel, but all electronic devices will be turned in upon arrival at camp, including camper cell phones. All items will be stored safely in a locked room until they are returned at the end of the week. Please label everything with your camper's name.
