



CAMP DETAILS & INFORMATION

We will be traveling to Quaker Ridge Camp (30150 N Highway 67, Woodland Park, CO) in an Arrow Stage Line charter bus with professional drivers.

We will be staying on the campgrounds in separate boy and girl cabins, sleeping in Dorm Style rooms with multiple sets of beds (bedding not provided).

Each room has access to bathroom facilities inside or close to their building (towels & toiletries not provided).

Camp payment along with Health, Consent & Release forms via both CampDoc.com and printed Activity Forms must be finished as soon as possible or by June 30 at the latest (*or your child's spot could be forfeited for someone on the wait list*).

Students may bring and use electronics during travel, but all electronic devices will be turned in upon arrival at camp, including camper cell phones. All items will be stored safely in a locked room until they are returned at the end of the week. Please label everything with your camper's name.

HEALTH & MEDICATION INFORMATION

There will be a Registered Nurse on site at all times administering meds and tending to any illness/injuries that may occur. All camp staff are trained in CPR and First Aid.

All camper medications (prescription and over the counter) will be turned in to the camp infirmary. Exceptions to this rule include inhalers & epi-pens. Please place all meds in a zip-loc bag and write the camper name along with their school name on the bag. You will give this baggy to one of the trip leaders when we gather on the evening of July 22. Prescription meds should come to camp in their original pharmacy container with patient name, dosage info, parent instructions, etc. **Please keep inhalers & epi-pens with the camper and not in this baggy.**

We will leave for camp in the early morning on **Sunday, July 22 at 1am.**

Meet at **Gretna Baptist Church** (20725 E Angus St, Gretna) between 10:30-11:30pm on **Saturday, July 22**. We will load and depart from there at 1am!
