



CAMP DETAILS & INFORMATION

We will be traveling to Sunstream Retreat Center (1130 Juneberry Rd, Ogden, IA) in Arrow Buses with professional drivers.

We will be staying on the campgrounds in separate boy and girl cabins, sleeping in Dorm Style rooms with multiple sets of bunk beds (bedding not provided).

Each room is equipped with a private, full bathroom with multiple sinks and shower stalls (towels & toiletries not provided).

Camp activities include: zip lining, rock wall, archery, swimming pool, low ropes course, game room, dodgeball, gagaball, human foosball, basketball & volleyball.

After online registration, your child's camp balance along with their online Health, Consent & Release form via CampDoc.com must be completed by June 30 (or your child's spot could be forfeited for someone on the wait list).

Students may bring and use electronics during travel, but all electronic devices will be turned in upon arrival at camp, including camper cell phones. All items will be stored safely in a locked room until they are returned at the end of the week. Please label everything with your camper's name. If you need to reach your child, use the emergency contacts below. Your camper may bring a camera to use for the week.

HEALTH & MEDICATION INFORMATION

There will be a Registered Nurse on site at all times administering meds and tending to any illness/injuries that may occur. All camp staff are trained in CPR and First Aid.

All camper medications (prescription and over the counter) will be turned in to the camp infirmary. Exceptions to this rule include inhalers & epi-pens. Please place all meds in a zip-loc bag and write the camper name along with their school name on the bag. You will give this baggy to one of the trip leaders before boarding the bus on August 2. Prescription meds should come to camp in their original pharmacy container with patient name, dosage info, parent instructions, etc. **Please keep inhalers & epi-pens with the camper and not in this baggy.**

DEPARTURE & ARRIVAL INFORMATION

We leave for camp on **Friday, August 2**.

Meet at Brookside Church (11607 M Cir, Omaha) between **8:30-9am**. Students can be dropped off as early as 8am if needed.

We will return on **Tuesday, August 6** to the same location at approximately **3pm**.
